Patrick Brendan McCoy, was born October 10, 1924 in Dundalk, Co. Louth, Ireland. He had an older brother, Leo who lived outside Toronto, Canada (deceased in 2012). His younger sister, Geraldine still resides in Dundalk in the home they grew up in. He worked in the local shoe factory for 8 years before planning his move to Canada at 23 years of age. Brendan jokes that he didn't know his full and first name was Patrick until he applied for passage to Canada. In Canada, Brendan trained to be an elevator mechanic, spending time in Toronto and Montreal before heading west to look for work in San Francisco, Vancouver then LA. He spent the majority of his career as an elevator mechanic for the USC Medical Center from which he retired in Sept 1991.In 1958, Brendan met and married his wife of 57 years Emily (Gaffney) McCoy. The couple welcomed 2 children (Brenda and Patricia), then moved to England (Emily's home) to make a go of it, where their 3rd child (Fiona) was born. They moved back to LA where child #4 (Teresa) was born then to New Zealand for 8 months before returning to LA where they welcomed their 5th and final child

(Ann) into their home. They settled in Downey where they lived for the next 35 years. He misses his wife Emily every day, who died in July 2015. Brendan always put his faith and family first. He is now a proud grandfather to 18 grandchildren and great-grandpa to 7 with one on the way.

If you know Brendan, you know he loves one liners...he's a jokester at heart. He tells us on a regular basis that "this getting old stuff is for the birds". Or, "I don't know how I'm going manage when I get old." He currently resides in Leisure World, Seal Beach, where he has lived for the past 17 years and loves to spend time with his children, grandchildren and great grandchildren...and of course, with his friends at the Irish Social at St. Cornelius.
